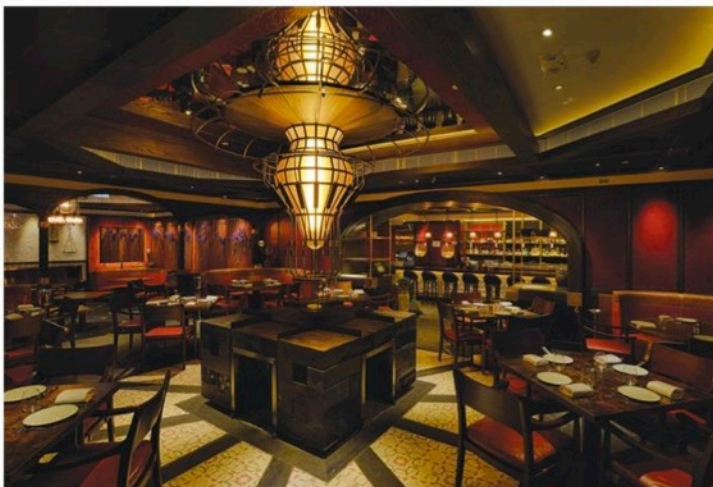

As if that wasn't enough, brunch will also offer the restaurant's signature Segovian style suckling pig, as well as traditional pans of paella, which will only be served at brunch. And of course, don't forget to order all of your favourite egg dishes, toasted bikini sandwiches and more before ending on a sweet note with seasonal Catalan fruits or churros with hot chocolate. The standard brunch is priced at \$590, but for an additional \$230, guests can enjoy unlimited Sangria cocktails and orange juice.
