Catalunya Launches Sunday Brunch

The fine dining Spanish restaurant will feature off-menu dishes and signature favourites during Sunday brunch

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While we at Hong Kong Tatler would prefer not to be in the vicinity of the office on the weekends, there's one exception – we'll make a trip to [Catalunya](#) (located in the same building as HKT headquarters) for their new Sunday brunch concept. Titled "Catalunya Sundays, Brunch with Passion", the fine dining Spanish restaurant will be open, as the name suggests, on Sundays to serve brunch. The brunch concept is based off the style of eating found at traditional Spanish markets (namely, Boqueria in Barcelona) where diners can pick and choose from various food stations offering a range of Catalan classics.

There will be stations serving all manner of dishes, such as the "Quesos" station serving cheeses, the fish bar serving raw, marinated and pickled seafood, a butcher station with surprise off-menu items such as beef tartar; and a "Guisos" station serving hearty Catalan stews. Other highlights at the Catalunya Sunday brunch include the restaurant's signature dishes such as the toasted "bikini" sandwiches, Segovian-style suckling pig, and paella.

The brunch is served every Sunday between 12pm and 4pm and is priced at HK\$590 per person; for an additional HK\$230, guests can enjoy free-flow Cava and signature sangria cocktails, or orange juice. For families, there will be a dedicated playground for young children aged between 3 and 7 years.
